### RMS Code of Conduct

At RMS, the expectation is that the school community follow the RMS Code of Conduct while on school campus. The Code of Conduct can be found on the school website.

### ALLERGIES

Some staff and students have severe allergies. **Students must not wear or bring scented products and students must not bring any products containing nuts.**

### ATTENDANCE – Safe Arrival/School Messenger/School Attendance

School attendance is mandatory for K-8 schools. With the Safe Arrival system, you can report your child's absence in advance whenever possible. Safe Arrival is an absence management system that improves student safety and makes it easy for you to let the school know about your child's absence.

### CLOSED CAMPUS

RMS is a closed campus, so students are not permitted to leave unless they are signed out in the office and picked up by their parent/guardian.

### BUSSES

Students are expected to maintain the same standard of behavior on the bus as is required at school. Students may only be transported on the bus to which they are assigned by the District Transportation Office. Students who leave the school property are not eligible for their bus on that day. ### SCHOOL BUS (BASIC RULES)

- Obey the driver
- Respect others
- Remain seated
- Keep the aisle clear
- Talk quietly

### FIRE DRILL/CRISIS RESPONSE

Throughout the school year, fire drills and crisis response training will be held. When a drill occurs, each student must:

1. Know the proper exit from any part of the building. Each room will have this information posted.
2. If the fire alarm should ring when classes are not in session (i.e., during lunch), leave the building via the nearest exit and proceed outside to the designated area for your homeroom class.
3. Walk in a quiet, orderly manner.
4. Stay with your teacher.
5. Exit the building and stay out until you are instructed to return.
6. Refrain from talking at all times.

Practice lock-down and evacuation drills are held to prepare students to respond appropriately in the event of a crisis. RMS evacuation site is the Chocolate River Station.

### DRUGS, ALCOHOL, AND WEAPONS

Any student possessing or using drugs, alcohol, or weapons at school or at school sponsored functions will be dealt with according to District Policy. This will involve notification of the parents, and/or police, and a suspension.

## **PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports)**

At Riverview Middles we have adopted a Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) approach for supporting *students'* behavioral, academic, social, emotional, and mental health. [A PBIS approach is](#) proven to improve the social emotional competence, academic success, and school climate. It also improves the teacher's health and wellbeing. It is a way to create positive, predictable, equitable and safe learning environments where everyone thrives. It is our ongoing commitment to positively supporting students, educators, and families.

## **STUDENT DROP OFF (7:45 – 8:05 am)**

Supervision for walking students and for student drop-off begins at 7:45 am.

Student Drop Off is located off Pine Glen Road. This was created to have a safe area for parents to drop off their child at school. **There is NO student drop-off on Devere Rd or Cleveland Ave.**

## **STUDENT PLACEMENT**

A great deal of time, effort and thought goes into the process of student placement each school year at Riverview Middle School.

Careful consideration is given with input from all staff based on each student's learning style and needs. Classrooms have been balanced academically and socially. Our class lists are structured to provide equitable class sizes at each grade level. Moving students is difficult without causing imbalances and inequities.

We encourage parents and guardians to be a positive role model for your child when discussing student placement and help them understand that it is not possible to place all students with a preferred friend or teacher. Our staff work hard to make school a positive experience for students. It is important to recognize that it can take a few weeks for a child to adjust to a new grade, peer group and teachers. The staff at RMS is eagerly looking forward to fostering your child's learning both academically and socially.

All visitors are to report to the office to sign-in. Please park in designated areas, and refrain from blocking the bus loading zone.

Disability parking is available at the side parking lot of the main entrance of the school and at the theatre parking area.
